1	Annual Declaration of Social Data (DADS)	Employment – Labour force	The DADS is a mandatory declarative formality for all companies with employees in application of the Social Security Code and the General Tax Code. After statistical processing, the INSEE currently produces and renders available five data sources from the DADS.
2	Annual Statistics of companies	Characteristics of enterprises	The Annual Statistics of Companies consist of multiple data sources based on the ESANE scheme. This scheme allows the production of the structural business statistics, which is an annual "snapshot" of the population of enterprises belonging to the productive system and their main characteristics.
3	Financial links between enterprises (LIFI)	Characteristics of enterprises	The LIFI surveys aim to identify and outline the groups of enterprises operating in France. It is the cornerstone of a scheme dedicated to the statistical knowledge of groups of enterprises.
4	Community innovation surveys (CIS)	Globalization and innovation	The original objectives of CIS are to measure the economic weight of innovation in France. From the 2018 CIS survey round, these objectives were extended to non-innovative companies, in particular for those concerning the innovation process.
5	Annual enterprises Survey (AES)	Characteristics of enterprises	The AES provides statistics on the main economic characteristics of enterprises in the sectors of transport, trade and services, construction and industry.
6	Directory of Enterprises and establishments (REE)	Business demography	The REE is the information system for the dissemination and study of demographic data for enterprises and establishments. Data from the REE are used to build the enterprise and establishment inventory databases and the annual databases for enterprise creations and establishment creations.
7	Population Census (RP)	Population change and structure	The RP is used to learn about France's diverse and changing population. It provides statistics on inhabitants and their characteristics: composition by gender and age, occupation, housing conditions, means of transportation...
8	Personal income tax returns (POTE)	Public finance	The POTE scheme contains data sources on personal income like the File of the 2042 returns of the tax households (POTE), the Sampled file of the income tax (FELIN) and the Aggregated income tax to the commune (IRCOM).
9	Datasets on the management of tax credits (BCGI)	Public finance	The BCGI scheme covers multiple administrative data sources from tax declarations like the file GECIR that contains the 2069-SD declaration on research tax credit and the MVC-CIR file that provides information on the initialized and consumed research tax credit receivables.
10	Annual production survey (EAP)	Characteristics of enterprises	The EAP aims to identify the different activities carried out by enterprises via the breakdown of their turnover into subsectors, and to deduce their main activity (APE), to provide elements allowing the production of high-quality data on industrial output in order to meet the requirements of the European PRODCOM regulation, but also to meet demands from national users.

1	Sample of Integrated Labour Market Biographies (SIAB)	Worker biographies	The SIAB is a 2 percent random sample drawn from the Integrated Employment Biographies (IEB) of the Institute for Employment Research (IAB). The IEB make it possible to track the employment status of a person exact to the day.
2	Linked-Employer-Employee-Data of the IAB (LIAB)	Linked employer-employee	The LIAB combine interviews from the IAB Establishment Panel with the related establishment and individual data generated in labour administration and social security data processing.
3	Establishment History Panel (BHP)	Establishment data	The BHP is composed of cross sectional datasets since 1975 for West Germany and 1992 for East Germany. Every cross section contains all the establishments in Germany which are covered by the IAB Employment History (BeH) on June 30th.
4	Panel Labour Market and Social Security (PASS)	Household survey on poverty	The PASS is a central dataset for research on the labour market, poverty and means-tested income support in Germany (German Social Code Book II).
5	IAB Establishment Panel (IAB-BP)	Establishment survey	The IAB-BP is an annual representative survey on various topics such as the determinants of labour demand. It has been conducted by the IAB since 1993 in West Germany and since 1996 in East Germany, too. The IAB Establishment Panel is the central basis for the analysis of labour demand in Germany.
6	Linked Personnel Panel (LPP)	Linked employer-employee	With the LPP, the IAB provides a novel data product for personnel economic research in Germany. The simultaneous observation of employer and employee perspective allows both cross and longitudinal analyses of the relationship between HR management, individual job quality and firm performance.
7	Biographical Data of Social Insurance Agencies in Germany (BASiD)	Retirement	The BASiD is a 1% sample of the population of the German Pension insurance related to the Sample of insured persons and their insurance accounts 2007 (Versichertenkontenstichprobe - VSKT).
8	IAB-SOEP Migration Sample (IAB-SOEP MIG)	Migration	The IAB-SOEP MIG provides information on various aspects of immigration regarding activation and attraction of skilled immigrants and to provide clear guidance regarding immigration, integration and labour market policies in Germany.
9	IAB Job Vacancy Survey (IAB SE)	Establishment survey	The IAB-SE is an establishment survey covering the entire unfilled labour demand in Germany.
10	Working and Learning in a Changing World (ALWA)	Learning	The ALWA-data contain information about more than 10.400 life histories and allows detailed longitudinal analysis in particular about schooling and training decisions, labour market re-entries and labour market behaviour as well as about processes of family formation and regional mobility.

1	Annual Respondents Database (ARD)	Business information	The ARD is constructed from a compulsory business survey. Until 1997 it was created out of the Annual Censuses of Production and Construction (ACOP and ACOC); these were combined into the Annual Business Inquiry (ABI) in 1998. The ARD is a census of large businesses, and a sample of smaller ones.
2	Scottish Employer Skills Survey (SESS)	Employers information	The SESS is a series of large scale surveys undertaken to obtain perspectives of employers on a wide range of workforce skills-related issues.
3	UK Innovation Survey (UKIS)	Business Innovation	The UKIS provides the main source of information on business innovation in the UK.
4	Annual Respondents Database X (ARDx)	Income, property and investment/saving	The ARDx has been created by researchers at the Office for National Statistics (ONS) Virtual Microdata Laboratory (VML) and the University of the West of England to allow users of Annual Respondents Database (ARD) (held at the UK Data Archive under SN 6644) to continue analysis even though the Annual Business Inquiry (ABI) which was used to create ARD ceased in 2008.
5	Workplace Employment Relations Survey (WERS)	Labour relations/conflict	The WERS is a national survey of the state of employment relations and working life inside British workplaces.
6	New Earnings Survey Panel Dataset (NESPD)	Wages	The NES is an annual survey of the earnings of employees in Great Britain. Its primary purpose is to obtain information about the levels, distribution and make-up of earnings, and for the collective agreements that cover them.
7	Millennium Cohort Study: (MCS)	Education	The MCS is a large-scale, multi-purpose longitudinal dataset providing information about babies born at the beginning of the 21st century, their progress through life, and the families who are bringing them up, for the four countries of the United Kingdom
8	National Employer Skills Survey (NESS)	Vocational education and training	The NESS collects data about the skills of the workforce of firms in England.
9	Research into the Barriers to Take-up and Use of Business Support	Business support	The Research into the Barriers to Take-up and Use of Business Support, 2011 study was a one-off survey concerned with the barriers to the take up of formal external assistance, the reasons for such barriers and whether there is evidence of market failure, and the extent of latent demand for business support services.
10	Longitudinal Small Business Survey (LSBS)	Business performance	The LSBS is a large-scale telephone survey of UK small business owners and managers, commissioned by the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills (BIS). It allows a detailed analysis of how combinations of factors affect business performance.

1	Business Structure Database (BSD)	Business information	The BSD provides a version of the Inter-departmental Business Register for research use, taking full account of changes in ownership and restructuring of businesses.
2	National Pupil Database	Education, demography	Administrative data from Department for Education on secondary education KS4 attainment or KS5 demographics. Access in SRS, DFE governance.
3	Annual Survey of Hours and Earnings (ASHE)	Employee information	The ASHE provides information about the levels, distribution and make-up of earnings and hours paid for employees by sex, and full-time and part-time working. Estimates are available for various breakdowns including industries, occupations, geographies and age groups within the UK.
4	Labour Force Survey (LFS)	Employment, Education, Economic activity	The primary purpose of the LFS is "providing good quality point in time and change estimates for various labour market outputs and related topics" (National Statistics Quality Review (NSQR) of Labour Force Survey 2014). The labour market covers all aspects of people's work, including the education and training needed to equip them for work, the jobs themselves, job-search for those out of work and income from work and benefits.
5	Annual Business Survey (ABS)	Business information	The ABS is an annual survey of businesses covering the production, construction, distribution and service industries, which represents about two-thirds of the UK economy in terms of Gross Value Added (GVA). The ABS is the largest business survey conducted by the ONS in terms of the combined number of respondents and variables it covers.
6	Annual Population survey (APS)	General and diverse employment information	The APS is a combined survey of households in the UK. Its purpose is to provide information on key social and socioeconomic variables between the 10-yearly censuses, with particular emphasis on providing information relating to sub-regional (local authority) areas.
7	Annual Respondents Database (ARDx, ARD)	Business information	The ARDx holds responses to the Annual Business Inquiry (ABI) mapped over time. The ABI was the most comprehensive business survey covering: turnover, costs, employment, industry, and investment. It is a census of large businesses, and a sample of smaller ones.
8	Business Enterprise Research and Development (BERD)	Innovation	The purpose of the BERD Survey is to provide estimates of businesses' expenditure and employment relating to research and development (R&D) performed in the UK. It uniquely provides information on expenditure on R&D performed by UK businesses, the source of funding for this R&D work, and the employment of people working on R&D.
9	Business Register and Employment Survey (BRES)	Business information; employment; industry	BRES publishes employee and employment estimates at detailed geographical and industrial levels. It is regarded as the definitive source of official government employee statistics by industry.
10	Census	People and household information	The microdata files consist of random samples of between 3% and 10% of individuals in the Census output database for the United Kingdom (for 1961 - 2011). 100% will be made available for 2011 Census

1	German General Social Survey (ALLBUS)	Economics	The ALLBUS original surveys have been designed to monitor trends in attitudes, behaviour, and societal change in the Federal Republic of Germany.
2	Children of Immigrants Longitudinal Survey in Four European Country (CILS4EU)	Immigration	This CILS4EU survey gives information on leisure behaviour, friendships, family, feelings and beliefs, identity, the current situation and vocational training of young people, sibling situation of children of immigrants.
3	Executive Survey on Public Sector Reform in Europe (COCOPS)	Public sector	The COCOPS survey provides quantitative data regarding public administration reforms and their impacts in Europe by exploring the perceptions, experiences and opinions of the actors strongly involved in the conception and implementation of reforms.
4	General Population Survey (EUANDI) - User Profiles in the 2019 European Elections	Information on population	The EUANDI survey gives the User's position on 30 political issues (Welfare, family and health, migration and immigration, society, religion and culture...).
5	Europe in Context	Local democracy	The study "Europe in Context" investigates the effects of individual features and the local context on political orientations.
6	Gesis Panel	General information	The GESIS Panel is multi-topic survey that takes place every two months.
7	German longitudinal Election Study (GLES)	Election	The GLES is the central infrastructure project in Germany for the continuous collection and provision of high-quality data for national and international election research. The methodologically diverse surveys of the GLES make it possible to investigate the political attitudes and behaviour of voters and candidates.
8	iFQ Survey of Scientists	Education	The iFQ survey renders available information on Research environment of professors at German universities, third party funding of research, attitudes toward science policy.
9	Kinship and Social Security (KASS)	Family relationships	The KASS surveys gives information on the scope and network of support relations, help for third parties, or of help persons themselves received from members of the network of friends and kin.
10	Mobility, Expectations, Self-Assessment and Risk Attitude of Students (MESARAS)	Mobility of students	The MESARAS-project was designed to investigate the interconnectedness of geographic mobility of highly qualified individuals and their personality and preferences.
